*Biographical Summary*

**Yemisi A. Bolumole** is Associate Professor of Supply Chain Management at the Eli Broad College of Business, Michigan State University, whose faculty she joined in 2011. Prior to joining MSU, she was an Associate Professor of Logistics at the University of North Florida (UNF), where she served as the Director of the Transportation and Logistics Flagship Program. She is a certified solutions architect and consultant for *mySAP ERP*. Dr. Bolumole earned her Bachelor's degree (1992) from University of Lagos, Nigeria, and her MA (Masters in the Arts) in Business and Management (1995) from the University of East London, in the United Kingdom. She received her MSc (Masters in Science) in Energy Conservation and the Environment (1997) and her PhD in Logistics & Supply Chain Management (2001) from Cranfield University in the United Kingdom. Her doctoral thesis, titled "*Logistics Outsourcing in the UK Forecourt Convenience Retail Sector: The Supply Chain Role of Third Party Service Providers*", was awarded the Director's prize for the best PhD dissertation in 2001. While a doctoral student, she was selected to participate in the 2000 Council of Logistics Management Annual Doctoral Consortium.

She is actively involved in research and teaching primarily focused in the areas of strategic logistics, logistics systems management, logistics outsourcing, performance measurement, and the cross-disciplinary areas within supply chain management. Her areas of research emphasis include the supply chain implications of third party logistics, performance metrics for outsourced logistics, partnering for optimizing supply chain performance and the strategic implications of supply chain management. Her research program to date has generated over 30 publications, including refereed journal articles in the *Journal of Business Logistics*, *Transportation Journal*, *International Journal of Logistics Management*, *International Journal of Production Research*, *Journal of Business and Industrial Marketing* and the *Cranfield School of Management Working Paper Series* (peer reviewed), as well as book chapters, numerous professional conference proceedings and other publications.

Dr. Bolumole's significant teaching accomplishments include the UNF Outstanding Undergraduate Teaching Award, which she received in 2006, in addition to annual evaluations of outstanding teaching performance for the entire duration of her professional career. She has taught in several executive education programs for the United States Army, also at the Ohio State University, the University of North Florida, Northwestern University, and Cranfield School of Management. Her recent clients include Vistakon, the National Paper Trade Association (NPTA) and its member distributor firms.

Dr. Bolumole has served on more than 40 different committees and other service assignments at UNF, MSU, within the Northeast Florida region and nationwide, including over 20 leadership positions. She is a regular speaker at sundry professional and academic events. Her current leadership and service roles include her role as Chair of APICS' new *CLTD* certification committee and editorial review board member for the *Journal of Business Logistics*, *Transportation Journal*, and *The International Journal of Logistics Management*; and board examiner for the *American Society of Transportation & Logistics*. She also served as advisory panel member for the Jacksonville Transportation Authority/Florida Department of Transportation Regional Transportation Agency Study. Her other service responsibilities and accomplishments include conference track chair, referee, session chair, examiner, presenter, speaker, discussant, education chair, and advisor for various professional organizations such as the Council of Supply Chain Management Professionals, the Chartered Institute of Logistics & Transportation, the American Society of Transportation & Logistics, Transportation Clubs International, the Traffic Club of Jacksonville, the Propeller Club of the United States, Port of Jacksonville, the CSCMP First Coast (Jacksonville) Roundtable.
